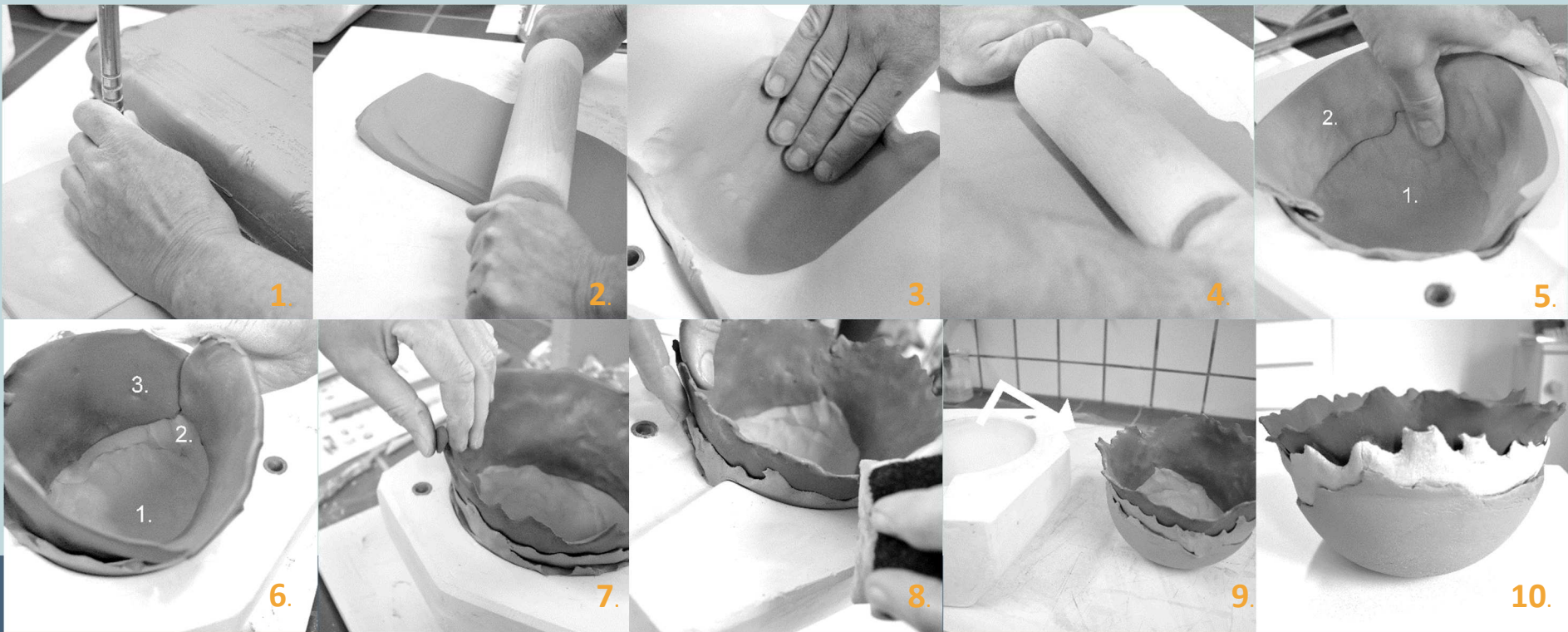

1. Cut a 0.5 - 1.0 cm large plate out of the body by using a clay cutter.

2. Roll out the plate by means of a rolling pin.

3. Mould carefully the plate into a hemispherical plaster mould and remove any excess material.

4. Now take the second body. Cut another plate and roll it out.

5. Model the 2. body on the upper edge of the 1. body (see picture). Excess material is again torn off.

6. Repeat step 4 and 5 with body 3 (see picture), so that 3 layers arise.

7. Frazzle a bit the outer edges of the three bodies by tearing off small pieces of the body (see picture)

8. Smooth out sharp "fringes" with a sponge.

9. After half an hour you can carefully take out the hemisphere from the mould.

10. Let the hemisphere dry and fire it. If the hemisphere is to be used later as a vase or flower pot, glaze the inside.
